## **GRADUATE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION AND ALLIED PROFESSIONS:**

This assistantship involves recruiting, training, and supervising the work of 100-150 undergraduate participants in the Literacy Project who work in Head Start classrooms in Bridgeport to enhance low income preschooler's language and school readiness skills. Most of the work takes place on campus but reliable transportation is necessary to do on-site visits at the Head Start sites in Bridgeport. Applicants must be available mornings and early afternoons.
