Are you interested in the care of Veterans and their families? We are actively recruiting for VA Nurse Scholars in their Sophomore and Junior years

What it means to be a VA Nurse Scholar:

- Honor and prestige of affiliation and participation in a select student cohort.
- Immersion in Veteran-Centric topics with a focus on unique health care needs of Veterans. With the unique knowledge and expertise of Veteran care, VA Nurse Scholar graduates will be more marketable in terms of employment when applying to any VA nursing positions nationwide.
- Eligibility to participate in VA-specific programs (as applicable/where available), including the VA Post Baccalaureate Registered Nurse Residency Program, VA Registered Nursing Transition- to-Practice Program, if hired by the VA post-licensure.

To be eligible you must:

- Be a natural-born or naturalized American Citizen
- Agree to complete the majority of your clinical rotations at VA Connecticut, as available
- Complete a transition course with a Capstone project on a Veteran-centric population issue, or complete the VA-STEP program
- Agree to annually update the VA Scholar Faculty at Fairfield University regarding current employment status, for 5 years after graduation

• Interested students must submit a completed application along with a 300-word essay describing your interest in becoming a VA Scholar, as well as the attributes you possess that would make you an ideal candidate for becoming a VA Nurse Scholar.
